Vocational school education is vocational education that is based on completed upper secondary education or equivalent prior learning. The educations have a scope of the half to the academic year and are part of the tertiary education, ie education at the level after upper secondary education. Vocational school education differs from higher education in several areas, among other things in that, for example, there is no requirement for study competence for admission. There is also no requirement for teaching in vocational schools to be research-based, as is the case for higher education. Vocational school education must to a greater extent be directly linked to the needs of working life. Higher education and vocational education are regulated through separate legislation.
